The new Choices Markets location will continue to serve the community as Drive Organics with the current staff staying on. In the coming months, the location will be rebranded as a Choices Markets and shelves will be stocked with even more local and organic food options as well as healthcare products that have become synonymous with the Choices Markets brand.

Founded in 1990 and owned by brothers Wayne and Lloyd Lockhart and Salim Ahmed, Choices Markets is Western Canada's largest local retailer of natural and organic foods. The chain has seven locations spanning Vancouver, Burnaby, South Surrey and Kelowna. Choices Markets also has a dedicated Gluten-Free Bakery in Vancouver and an industrial kitchen and bakery in Richmond. The Drive Organics location will be the company's eighth store.
